Since our last Newsletter in May, much has happened at Church of Hope. After being located at Hosier Lane for the previous three years, the lease for the premises was not renewed. However God was very faithful, causing alternative venues for the Saturday night meetings to immediately become available.

Our Saturday night meetings which have been well attended for the past three and a half years are continuing to grow in size. Due to the generous support of the Lutheran Church and the availability of a hall in Richmond, these meetings continued on from the moment we left our old premises in Hosier Lane.

The Saturday night meetings have also given a number of churches the opportunity of being a part of the ministry to the street people in Melbourne. Close to 100 people attended our last Saturday night meeting when Howard Willard preached at our church. God has continued to bless our Saturday night meetings and many of those attending our church in Melbourne have grown in their faith.

The Thursday night Bible study has also not been affected by our move and has been held at the Hungry Jacks store since leaving Hosier Lane. We are now looking at relocating this to the Lutheran Church Hall on Thursdays between 5.00 and 7.00 pm from the first of November .

We are now also looking at next year hiring a bigger venue for the Saturday night meetings which are continuing to grow in size. With a strong leadership team we are also prayerfully seeking the Lord's timing to find some permanent premises again.

Our Church's move from Hosier lane also made available to us extra finances which were used in part to support a 7 week missions trip to India, in which 80 Pastors in Kakinada were equipped and trained in the area of evangelism and church planting by Conrad and Marian Fenton. Our church was able to partly support some of the expenses associated with this missions trip.

David Palmer and his wife Melanie have been doing a good job running the Church in Melbourne, since Conrad and Marian Fenton moved to Sydney to pioneer a new work in Kings Cross and to establish an ongoing Missions work in India. The rental savings since moving from Hosier Lane have also enabled our Church to support some of the key ministries in India on an ongoing basis.

In Sydney, leadership training nights are now being held every Wednesday night for those involved in the Kings Cross Church Plant. Conrad and Marian are now in the process of commencing monthly BBQ outreaches in the heart of Kings Cross as they look to establish a discipleship and Ministry Training Centre in Kings Cross.

As we look to 2008, the focus of Church of Hope will be to mentor and raise up the next group of leaders as we look to expanding our street outreaches and ministries to the poor and marginalised people in Melbourne, Sydney and India.

### MELBOURNE HIGHLIGHTS

- God was faithful in immediately providing two new venues for our Saturday night meetings.
- Tarun Stevenson ministered in testimony and song at one of our meetings.
- Gary Walker holds a discipleship class at Hungry Jacks each Thursday night.
- God has raised up a great ministry team in Melbourne which has a heart to see a 24/7 centre being eventually opened in the City.
- Conrad Fenton was able to share the heart of our church and its ministries on 89.9 Light Fm
- Chris Elliot recently joined our Saturday night worship meetings. His heart for worship and gifts in music and singing has encouraged many.
- Close to 100 people attended our Saturday night meeting to hear Howard Willard speak.
- God has blessed our Church since we have begun to equip and help support 130 pastors in India, and to feed 50 orphans in Bangalore.

# **MISSIONS TRIP TO INDIA** (July 16 - September 5th 2007)

#### INDIA MISSION HIGHLIGHTS

- A three week pastor's workshop in Kakinada equips and  $\Box$ empowers 80 pastors in the area of evangelism and church planting. The pastors also experienced personal revival during this workshop. (Originally only 50 pastors were registered).
- The pastor's conference held in Kakinada touched many pastors, and 508 were encouraged to seek God's vision and plan for their church. (Originally only 300 were expected to attend).
- All of the children in the Bright Hope Children's Home in Kakinada were worshipping the Lord, and many of them prayed for the lepers in Kakinada.
- God's mercy has touched the Christian leper's camp, where not one child has contracted leprosy from their
- Five pastor's meetings in Survapet greatly encouraged 50 pastors who will now be meeting every month.
- Several pastor's conferences were organised in the city of Bangalore, which created a fresh passion amongst the pastors to see their churches being more active in evangelising their community.
- A young child was healed of a severe skin condition that had scarred his face. Many others were also healed.
- In Kakinada 380 pastors were given a ministry training manual, and 450 pastors were given an outreach DVD.
- Four village crusades saw every person in the village given a gospel tract and hearing the gospel message.
- It was very inspiring to see the passion of the Indian pastors praying and worshiping the Lord.
- of these ministries in India, to help them see the many villages touched by the gospel message, and to help feed  $\,^{\square}$ the 50 orphans in the orphanage in Bangalore.

Pastor Silvi from Survapet is wanting to give 100 pastors in all 23 Districts in Andhra Pradesh our Ministry Training Manual. The cost to produce 2,300 of these manuals would be \$4,000





#### GOD'S LOVE FOR EVERY PERSON (Pastor John Mark from Survapet)

During their recent trip to India, Pastor Silvi from Suryapet rang Conrad and Marian Fenton to see if they could visit him and the other pastors in Survapet. After 21 days of continuous ministry, and only one week to rest before 14 more days of continuous ministry, Conrad really felt led of the Lord to squeeze two days of ministry in at Suryapet.

As it turned out this was one of the highlights of the India trip. Five meetings were held during two days. During this time in Suryapet Conrad and Marian were introduced to Pastor John Mark, who two weeks earlier had wanted to give up on life. Had it not been for the encouragement of Pastor Silvi, he most likely would have taken his life. (How we all need each other in the Body of Christ).

His wife had been given only 6 months to live due to heart problems, he had financial debts resulting from having to borrow money to feed the orphans in the orphanage, after a ministry which had previously supported John Mark's ministry had a change of leader after the death of the founder of this ministry. Five years ago Pastor John Mark had 50 evangelists who were supported by this ministry. Now with no support coming from this ministry, all the evangelism had come to a halt.

When we came to Suryapet, Pastor John Mark was greatly encouraged during the 5 meetings. He had also had a dream of two people coming to help him the day before Marian and Conrad arrived in Suryapet. After prayer his wife was miraculously healed, and Church of Hope was able to give him some money to pay the outstanding bills in relation to the feeding of the orphans.

His proposed church building was only a slab. With no money to build the church and a pile of bricks on the concrete slab, Conrad was impressed to put before the Church of Hope Board a motion for Church of Hope to help Pastor John Mark to complete the construction of the church building. (\$AU 2,000)

Church of Hope is now giving \$AU 500 per month to help the church construction. At the meetings in Suryapet 50 Pastors attended. Now every month Pastor Silvi and Pastor John Mark are holding pastor's conferences to help encourage the village pastors. Pastor John Mark, Pastor Silvi and all the other pastors have now all been filled with a fresh passion to see the State of Andhra Pradesh won to Jesus.

#### 10 TRACTS PER DAY

If a person gave out or letter box dropped just 10 gospel tracts per day, five days a week, over the course of one year they would have distributed 2,500 tracts. If everyone in a church of 200 did the above, the church would collectively that distribute half a million tracts per year.

Tracts can be produced for as little as 1-2 cents each. Gospel tracts can be downloaded from our website at www.coh.org.au and photocopied. Working as a team, the churches collectively could see everyone in our City receiving gospel tracts, with many coming to faith in Jesus Christ. The harvest truly is ripe but the labourers are few.

(Eph. 2:10) God's plan for our life will truly fulfil us and give us a great sense of purpose in our life. (Jer. 29:11) Jesus Himself said, "... #### **BUILDING A MINISTRY TEAM**

Since coming back from India, Conrad and Marian Fenton have been focused on the ministry in Kings Cross and the establishing of a ministry team. There is now a team of 5 which is committed to coming out to Kings Cross on a Saturday afternoon.

We have now also resumed our Street Outreach in George Street Sydney. We are now holding this outreach on a Friday night and many Christians from different churches will be joining this church wide outreach. A big focus of these Friday night City outreaches will be to help raise up many street preachers.

Over the months to come we are hoping that many other church groups will be encouraged to join our ministry teams to share the gospel the multitudes who venture into the city every Friday and Saturday night.

The Wednesday night discipleship classes leading up to this Christmas will have a particular focus of equipping Christians for the work of evangelism, and to prepare them reach out to the lost in Sydney. The second focus is the equip and mentor a core team who will be a part of the ministry team when the House of Hope opens in Kings Cross. Next year the Wednesday night meetings will have a focus on training up small group leaders to run house groups in Kings Cross

We are now also in the process of getting a permit to run on the third Sunday of each month, a community BBQ in Kings Cross (Fitzroy Gardens) to practically demonstrate the love of Christ in the Community. We are trusting God to provide the finances to make these community outreaches a great success. (Donations can be made to the Church on the Cross Account)
