EXPANDING BLACKTOWN OUTREACH MISSION

The Church in Blacktown has continued to gain strength as we see those in our church growing in their spiritual walk. Due to the great needs of many of the people in our city, we have several meetings during the week so that people can be encouraged in their walk with the Lord. Our Monday Night Prayer meeting continues to grow and our family Saturday Cafe Style Church continues to see lives being changed. Our Street outreaches in Blacktown and Penrith have continued to impact the lives of many people as more and more people continue to make commitments to Christ.

We are now also running a fortnightly outreach church meeting at the St Clair's Skate Park with our youth pastor Moses who is overseeing this meeting. A key focus in the coming months will be on training up more leaders in our fortnightly Leadership Classes as we look at expanding our Care and Outreach ministries. This year we will also be holding our fourth Carols by Candlelight Outreach at the Blacktown Showground working together with a number of other churches. Over the coming months we will also be doing more evangelism outreaches in other parts of Sydney as we realise the urgency for people to hear the gospel message in the times that we are now living in. Below is a picture of one of our previous carols events at the Blacktown Showground. Last year 1,500 attended the Carols by Candlelight event. One big thanks to Metro Signs who provided all of the banners for this event.



MARCH 2017 AFRICA MISSIONS TRIP



Pastor Conrad and Joe Askew had a fruitful Missions trip to Kenya and Malawi in March. All three of the Pastors workshops were well attended and many pastors were encouraged through the teachings. Tony Kauhiva also participated in the Nairobi workshop and preached at Bishop Benson's church. Around 300 Pastors Workshop Manuals were given to the pastors attending the workshops. Many new contacts for future Missions trips were also established during this trip. Pastor Conrad and Joe also preached at a number of churches in Kenya and Malawi as well as spending much fellowshipping with Bishop Benson who is our Church of Hope Coordinator in Africa. In Mombasa many people responded to an alter call and committed their lives to Jesus Christ after Pastor Conrad preached a message on the importance of maintaining a right heart. (See picture above) Pastor Conrad and Joe will be returning to Africa in March 2018 to do further workshops in Uganda and South Africa. SEVENTEEN WEEK EMAIL COURSE

Pastor Conrad continues to run by email the 17 week Evangelism and Ministry Training Course which has been so far run by around 1,000 pastors. For the first half of 2017 there are 195 pastors participating in this course with many also running this course for others. This course can be accessed on our Church of Hope Website www.coh.org.au. This free course had been designed to help equip and empower the poorer pastors in India and Africa who have had little or no bible college training. Being an email course it can be easily forwarded on to others who have a desire to complete this course and has the benefit of reducing printing costs for those with limited budgets.





Over 50 pastors attended the three day workshop in Malawi. All the pastors were greatly encouraged as Pastor Conrad and Joe Askew taught from our Church of Hope Pastors Workshop Training Manual

The Melbourne Saturday Night Worship Meeting continues to grow with now around 100 people attending each week's meeting. Mick Thompson has now joined our ministry team in Melbourne and is now leading our street outreaches in Melbourne. This year we are doing outreaches on both Tuesday and Friday nights near the steps of St Paul's Cathedral as we realise the urgency for evangelism. Pastor David and the team in Melbourne continue to be supported by a number of other churches and Christian groups who supply the meals for the Saturday Night meetings. Diana continues for the 12th year in a row to do a great job of organizing the groups that provide the food.

NOVEMBER INDIA MISSIONS TRIP



Pastors from several other North India States will be also attending this workshop. Dr Rajesh Malaki who helped to organize last year's Delhi Pastors Workshop will be again helping to facilitate this workshop. Moses Odur, who is our youth pastor, will also be joining Pastor Conrad on this 18 day mission's trip from the 9-27th of November.

The focus of this workshop will be on equipping those who attend to run further workshops for those in their network of pastors. Pastor Conrad is currently praying about which other states to visit in India after receiving many invitations from pastors to do workshops in their areas. Given that many of the pastors that we minister to in India and Africa are very poor, Church of Hope has a real heart to resource as many pastors as possible with free Pastors Workshop Training Manuals. Due to the support of many other Christians and Churches we have been able to print out and distribute thousands of manuals to pastors in India and Africa. Pastor John Mark is running workshops every month for groups of 50 pastors in many of the more remote areas of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh in South India.

OVERVIEW OF 2017 MISSIONS PROGRAM

- To resource overseas pastors to run more workshops this year by providing them with Pastors Workshop Manuals
- Supporting Bishop Benson and Pastor John Mark to run workshops this year to help equip more Pastors to run workshops in Africa and India
- Pastor Conrad with the assistance of Moses Odur, will be teaching at a three day Pastors Workshop in Haryana from the 22-24th of November to help equip pastors from several North India States. The focus for this workshop will be on equipping many pastors to run further Pastors Workshops throughout North India as well as helping them to run the 17 week Evangelism and Ministry Training Course for their network of pastors
- A continuing focus on our street churches in Blacktown (See picture below) and Penrith and now also in the St Clare's Skate Park and our outreaches in Melbourne on the steps of St Pauls.
- We will be running more evangelism outreaches in other areas of West Sydney including Kingswood and Hornsby. As part of the Kingswood Outreach we will be providing a sausage sizzle and gifts for the children as we look at sharing the love of Christ in this housing commission area, and
