LOCAL MISSIONS (Melbourne and Sydney)

With all that is happening in the world at present, a key focus both in Melbourne and in Sydney in 2015 will be on seeing the gospel shared with as many people as possible. We will also be having a greater focus on helping to equip and encourage other Christians to share their faith and to become soul winners. In Melbourne our Saturday night meeting will again have a focus on helping people to come to Christ as we encourage more people that we meet at our Flinders Street Station Outreach to attend our worship meeting. In Sydney we will be again doing street outreaches in the city as part of our ministry. In preparation for this we are printing out 42,500 gospel tracts. Our key focus in Blacktown will be on continuing to reach out into the community in our street outreaches near the station and encouraging people to connect with our Centre activities so as to grow in their walk with the Lord.

OVERSEAS MISSIONS PROGRAM

The Primary focus in the first half of 2015 will be to help support both Bishop Benson in Africa and Pastor John Mark in India to run Pastors Fire Workshops to help equip and encourage hundreds of remote village pastors. On the 27th of this month Bishop Benson will be running a workshop in Tanzania for 100 pastors.

In the first week of March, Pastor John Mark will be running a pastors workshop for 200 pastors. We are praying that we can continue to support both Bishop Benson and Pastor John Mark by providing the finances needed to print out hundreds of workshop manuals this year to give to the poorer remote village pastors.
