2022 - A YEAR FOR LOCAL EVANGELISM IN AUSTRALIA

This year we are having a far greater focus on local evangelism as we see the great need for Australia to come to Christ. For this reason we will be doing several country town outreaches in the first half of this year in NSW and one in Bacchus Marsh in Victoria. Blacktown will continue to be our base for training up and equipping Christians for evangelism. A big focus for our Thursday night Blacktown street church outreaches is to help give Christians the opportunity of sharing their faith and testimony and to provide a place of fellowship for our Evangelism team. Pastor Antony now leads the Thursday night meetings when Pastor Conrad is ministering in other areas. Pastor Conrad is now also pioneering a second fortnightly evangelism training base in Parramatta as well as taking teams to other Sydney Railway stations for one-off outreaches.






BLACKTOWN CHURCH – SEEING LIVES RESTORED

A key focus this year is to help see broken lives in Blacktown being restored as we also have a greater pastoral and teaching focus in our Thursday night street church meetings at the Blacktown Railway Station. We are now also holding monthly community breakfasts as part of our Sunday meeting as well as coffee and chat meetings on Monday as we look at helping to create healthy Christian community in Blacktown where people can feel loved and accepted.



ZOOM OVERSEAS CONFERENCES AND MEETINGS

During the four month lockdown last year in Sydney Pastor Conrad began ministering on Facebook. As a result of this around 40 pastors from overseas connected with him during the lockdown period. Through these connections we held four conferences for overseas pastors in Pakistan and India via zoom. Pastor Conrad also ministered to three of Pastor Daud's church fellowships in different areas of Pakistan as well as to three churches in India. Pastor Daud (pictured below) has pioneered many churches in the poor brick kiln areas of Pakistan. Due to the success of these meetings we will be doing several Sunday 5-6 PM zoom messages in 2022 for overseas church fellowships.

CHURCH OF HOPE MELBOURNE

Pastor David along with Chris Simmons, Donato Diele and Ivan Bell continue to oversee our ministries in Melbourne. An important part of our ministry continues to be our Friday night evangelism outreaches on the steps of Flinders Street Station. With many people in need of Christ, Pastor David is encouraging more people to join our outreaches in Melbourne.

Despite the Covid 19 restrictions in Victoria, Church of Hope has been able to continue its ministry to the poor and marginalized by offering dinner packs, food parcels, blankets and hygiene packs each Saturday to the people that we serve from the garage of the church that we are sub-leasing from in Melbourne.

We have also been blessed with many people helping to volunteer for the serving of the food parcels and meals. (See pictures below) The Greek Orthodox Church has also helped greatly by providing many meals for the poor. CLA continues to be a great support and encouragement for our Melbourne work.

Once the Covid 19 restrictions have been lifted we will resume our in-house Saturday night meetings at our leased premises in Melbourne. This year Pastor David is also looking at starting some mid week small groups to help disciple those in our Melbourne church. The first running of this course commences on Monday the 21st of February. Around 1,400 pastors and Christians have now completed this course over the past 6 years. SYDNEY WIDE RAILWAY STATION OUTREACHES



In the book of Acts we read,

"Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word." (Acts 8:4)

This year the Lord has put on the heart of Pastor Conrad to see all railways stations in Sydney having a one-off outreach. With a large team of evangelists we are now looking at mobilising more outreaches to touch the greater Sydney area with the gospel message. With an urgency now to reach people with the gospel we realise the importance of mobilising more of our evangelism team to reach out to different locations in Sydney. So far in 2022 we have already visited 10 railway stations in Sydney to distribute gospel tracts.

As people are most receptive to receiving a gospel tract when they see it for the first time, having one-off evangelism outreaches at all railway stations during 2022 will be the most effective way of distributing our gospel tracts. We have now had our first run of 103,000 gospel tracts printed to begin distributing at the railway stations in Sydney.

Railway Stations are a great place to distribute tracts during peak times because many people from various locations come through the exits at the railway stations. In addition to the one-off outreaches we will also be doing monthly or fortnightly outreaches at the following key railway stations in Sydney: Parramatta, Bankstown, Campbelltown and Hornsby. The focus at these four stations will be both the preaching of the gospel and the distribution of the tracts as we look at both helping to bring people to Christ and encouraging backslidden Christians to return to Christ.





COUNTRY TOWN OUTREACHES - NSW



With the pastoral support of Pastor John Botitu, Pastor Antony, Allan Bosco, John Steggles and Lito Obejas, Pastor Conrad will now be able to lead teams to several country towns this year to hold 5-6 day outreaches. After three successful outreaches to Dubbo, Lismore and Newcastle last year the Lord has put on the heart of Pastor Conrad to do the following outreaches in the first half of 2022:

Forbes/Parkes: Tuesday 22/2/22 to Sunday 27/2/22 Bathurst: Wednesday 16/3/22 to Sunday 20/3/22 Bacchus Marsh: Thursday 14/4/22 to Friday 15/4/22

Canberra: Thursday 28/4/22 to Saturday 30/4/22 Orange: Tuesday 17/5/22 to Sunday 22/5/22, and

Dubbo/Wellington: Tuesday 14/6/22 to Sunday 19/6/22 (Will also have a training focus for churches)

The whole purpose of these trips will be to saturate the towns with gospel tracts, to bring worship and the gospel message into the heart of the towns and to encourage the local Christians and churches. (Pictured below is one of our outreach teams)

CARE SUPPORT (Local and overseas)

Through our many overseas missions' trips and now also through the pastors that have connected with us through Facebook during the Covid 19 lockdown period, we now have a number of pastors that we relate to through zoom meetings. As a part of our zoom meetings to the poorer churches in Pakistan and India, if possible, we try to contribute to provide a meal for those who attend. The Christians that we minister to in Pastor Daud's churches are very poor. Typically, the Christians who work in the brick kilns in Pakistan start work from the age of 6 and on average earn only \$2-3 a day. We also have pastors that we have related to for 15 years such as Pastor John Mark in India who have orphans. Being a faith-based ministry, we can only help these overseas pastors as funds come into our Church accounts.
