OVERVIEW OF CHURCH OF HOPE MINISTRIES

This year Church of Hope will again be focusing on both evangelism and disciple making as we see a great need in this nation to see people coming to Christ and Christians being encouraged to grow in their spiritual walk.

The focus in Melbourne will continue to be on ministering to those in the marginalized community as well as continuing to reach out to the lost in the city through our evangelism outreaches each Friday.

Church of Hope NSW will again be focusing on reaching out to those in the streets of Blacktown and now also St Marys with Pastor John Botitu leading a fortnightly outreach there. This year a key focus in our Blacktown church will be on helping the marginalized Christians to grow in their Christian walk as we also make prayer a greater focus.

Evangelism will again be a big focus this year in NSW as we look at sending out more evangelism teams across Sydney and regional NSW and Victoria and equipping more Christians to share their faith.

CHURCH OF HOPE NSW - BLACKTOWN CHURCH

The discipleship vision for our Blacktown church this year is to help those who attend our church to grow spiritually and to become disciple makers themselves and to connect with their callings.

To help achieve this we will continue to focus on creating healthy Christian community in our Sunday meetings as we continue to minister the word of God to those attending our meetings. Weekly bible studies will also be made available to take home.

Our leaders will also be mentoring one or two key people this year as we look at establishing more small groups to meet people's pastoral needs.

This year we will be commencing a fortnightly small group for our worship team whilst Marcia Pitt will be running a fortnightly fellowship meeting for the women. This year Pastor Conrad will continue to run a fortnightly leadership study as well as commencing a foundations class each Wednesday fortnight with the help of John Steggles and Marcia Pitt to help people to lead victorious Christian lives.

MELBOURNE MINISTRY (Pastor David Palmer)

The vision for Church of Hope this year is based on Isaiah 61. The first part of verse one reads, "The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to [a]heal the broken-hearted, ..." (Isaiah 61:1)

This year the Lord has brought Ravi and Chris Maistry to our Melbourne church who have had experience in the area of "Inner healing" and helping people to be healed of emotional hurts. With many people coming from broken homes this couple will be a great addition to our ministry team. After sharing at our Saturday meetings this couple will be available for people to have personal ministry time. The Lord has also brought many new volunteers to Church of Hope Melbourne this year to help serve, disciple and care for those who attend our church. All volunteers have been encouraged to actively build relationships with those who attend our meetings and to minister into people's lives. Our aim this year is to also see the building that we hire being used more for discipleship and personal ministry.











BLACKTOWN PASTORAL CARE MINISTRY

The pastoral care ministry is an important part of our Blacktown ministry as people thrive in an atmosphere of love and acceptance. Having fellowship over food is a great way of creating healthy community. With many lonely and marginalized people in Blacktown, our food fellowship after church on Sunday and our monthly breakfast before our main worship meeting help us to build relationships with those in our community. As part of our care ministry, we provided a lunch for those who had no family to spend Christmas day with. Around 40 people attended throughout the course of this lunch. (Picture below)

This year we will continue to have our Monday Morning Coffee and Chat meetings for those in need of encouragement and fellowship. Marcia will also be organizing a light lunch for our fortnightly Women's Fellowship meeting. A free lunch will also be provided for those who attend our new foundations class. 

- Taking the gospel across Sydney and Regional New South Wales and Northern Victoria
- Training up and <u>mobilising</u> more Christians to become soul winners and evangelists, and
- Stirring up a heart for soul winning in Churches across Australian and abroad

To help see the above vision becoming a reality in 2023 we will be doing the following outreaches and initiatives:

- Focused Evangelism: (Weekly Street Church in Blacktown and fortnightly outreaches in St Marys, Penrith, Parramatta and at the Sydney University)
- Mass Evangelism: (Fortnightly George St Sydney outreaches - Friday night / Tuesday Lunch time)
- Sending out more outreach teams 2x2 (Multiplication of teams means more souls)
- **Personal Evangelism:** (Sharing our faith one on one with others. <u>Helping to equip the wider body</u> of Christ to become soul winners)
- Letter box evangelism (Resourcing Christians with gospel tracts. A great way to reach the elderly)
- Saturday March 25th Fire Workshop (A one-day evangelism fire workshop for pastors and Christians to stir up a passion for soul winning),
