DISCIPLES / SOULS / MULTIPLICATION

This year Church of Hope NSW has a three-fold focus of making disciples, helping to see souls won to Christ through evangelism outreaches and mobilizing more Christians in the area of evangelism (Multiplication).

A key focus this year will be on making disciples in Blacktown and training up Christians both here in Australia and overseas to become soul winners.

In this newsletter we will be outlining the ministry activities planned for 2024 to help see the above vision come to pass as well as the ministry activities planned for our Melbourne church.

ST MARYS SMALL GROUP

Last November Pastor Conrad and Marian with a small team commenced a weekly small group meeting at their place in St Marys with the view of helping their neighbours to be evangelized and discipled after some of them had come to Christ.

This small group is also for those who have a heart for the St Marys community. The vision for this small group is to help equip and train up those attending to eventually commence their own house group fellowship meetings.

BLACKTOWN PASTORAL MINISTRY FOCUS:

This year we will be having a greater discipleship focus in Blacktown as we seek to see those particularly from the marginalized community growing deeper in their Christian walk.

To help achieve this we will be continuing our weekly lunch time street church in the heart of Blacktown which runs from 10.30 am to 1.00 pm. As part of these weekly meetings, we will share both a twenty-minute evangelism message and a twenty-minute teaching message to help encourage and strengthen the Christians in the marginalized community in their walk with the Lord as we also pastorally input into their lives.

Our Sunday worship meetings and Monday morning coffee and chat meetings will continue to focus on creating healthy Christian community. On February the 14th we will be commencing the Alphacrucis foundational discipleship course in our Blacktown Centre. This course will run fortnightly for 13 sessions with small group interaction being a key focus in these meetings.







MELBOURNE MINISTRY VISION

This year we will again be having a major focus in Melbourne on making mature disciples. To help achieve this we will be doing the following initiatives in 2024:

- 1. Having a bible study prior to church
- 2. Each week having a very practical thoughtprovoking short message before the meal
- 3. We will be having a greater focus this year on mentoring both leaders and potential leaders
- 4. We will be having a continued focus on discipling both new and mature Christians
- 5. Caring for those struggling in life, practically, emotionally and spiritually will be a focus, and
- We will continue to practically help those who attend through the provision of meals and food, clothing, sleeping bags and pocket bibles to encourage people to search for God

Evangelism will continue to be a major focus each Friday night with Chris Simmons and Rene Stephens heading the outreaches in Melbourne. Pastor David will continue to evangelise people one-on-one in the streets of Melbourne whilst also inviting them to our Saturday night meetings.

Nutritious meals will continue to be provided each Saturday night to those who attend. One big thanks again to all the church groups and volunteers who help to provide the food each Saturday. Donations towards our Melbourne care expenses can be made into the following account.

BLACKTOWN INSIDE & OUTSIDE CHURCH MEETINGS

Last year the Lord put on Pastor Conrad's heart to commence lunch time outreaches in Main Street Blacktown with the view of ministering into the lives of those particularly from the marginalized community and those from other religions. There was much fruit from those outreaches with around 40 people from the marginalized community attending our Christmas Day lunch. In the first week of February, we will be commencing our first Street (Outside) Church meeting for 2024 with again a real pastoral and teaching focus.

Each week both evangelism and teaching messages will be shared to help people come to Christ and to be strengthened in their faith.

Our Sunday worship meetings (Inside Church) will continue to have a great worship and teaching focus as well as prayer for those with needs.

Each Monday night we will continue to have our prayer revival meetings in our Blacktown centre as we pray for transformation in Blacktown.



CREATING A SMALL GROUP CULTURE IN BLACKTOWN

Nurtured people become strong people. Helping to connect those from the marginalized community into a healthy small group this year will be a key focus as part of our Discipleship vision for our Blacktown church.

A key focus as part of our Alphacrucis foundational discipleship course in our Blacktown Centre will be on setting up several small groups to discuss the topics that are being covered each session. In doing this future small group leaders can be prepared to run their own small groups in the future.

- Our weekly Thursday night outreaches in Blacktown with now have both an evangelism and training focus to help raise up more street preachers
- We will be mobilising more evangelism teams in the city of Sydney every Friday as we continue to equip more Christians to start new outreaches
- We will be holding outreaches at ten major railway stations across Sydney and in Kings Cross this year
- We will be holding week long outreaches in the four major cities of Australia and in Canberra, and
- In December we will be holding a 12-day outreach along the NSW south coast with a youth focus
