

DROP IN CENTRE CHURCH - BLACKTOWN

As outlined in our previous October mission's newsletter, Church of Hope (NSW) will be opening up a Drop in Centre church in Blacktown next year to reach out to the many disadvantaged people that daily spend time in the heart of Blacktown. After outreaching every Thursday night near Blacktown Railway station for the past year, our church has now connected with many people who now need to be encouraged and built up in their faith.

Helping people come to Christ and to be built up in their walk with the Lord will be a key focus of the Drop in Centre Church. We are now praying that many people will sow into this vision to help see the lives of many disadvantaged people in Blacktown being transformed by the love of Christ.

VISION FOR DROP IN CENTRE CHURCH

To provide a place of fellowship and belonging in which people can grow in their Christian faith: Our focus will be on:

- Creating Healthy Loving Community
 (A place of acceptance and belonging)
- 2) Connecting with and encouraging the marginalized and disadvantaged
- 3) Teaching practical biblical life keys to help people to live meaningful lives
- 4) Helping people to connect with Jesus Christ (the key to lives being changed)
- Providing meals for the disadvantaged and other care
- 6) Praying for people with needs
- Helping people to connect with God's plan for their life,
- Training up leaders to pioneer new centres, and
- 9) Training up and equipping Christians to run local evangelism outreaches and overseas pastors workshops
