Good Evening

It is Pastor Conrad with week 15 of the Church of Hope Evangelism and Ministry Training Course.

I trust that you have had a good start to the week.

The topic for this week (Study Guide Number 12) is: Keys to building healthy ministry teams (Encouraging all believers to use their spiritual gifts)

In this week's teachings we cover the following areas:

- Firstly, the importance of being a visionary pastor who looks at raising up ministry teams and small groups to meet the pastoral needs of those in the church and who focuses on raising up ministry teams and groups within the church to perform ministry functions.

In relation to this I have shared in this week's study guide a key to church growth which is a pastor going from being a sheepherder (a pastor who tries to meet the pastoral needs of every one himself) to being a Rancher (a pastor who delegates the pastoral responsibilities to others and looks at raising up and releasing others into different ministry roles) It is this latter type of pastor who has the potential to see their church growing into a larger multisite church

- Secondly, I have looked at some keys to building strong ministry teams
- Thirdly, I have looked at some keys to helping to maintain unity in our teams. This is crucial to the success of any team. (Matthew 12:25) (Psalm 133:1-3) and
- Fourthly, I have looked at some things to consider in relation to using our spiritual gifts to bless others.

After putting this teaching together I have become personally encouraged to spend more time developing key leaders to run different ministries in the life of our new church here in Blacktown. Training up and delegating ministry responsibilities to others is a key to seeing a church growing stronger both in size and in spiritual maturity

It is so important that as Senior Pastors we invest our lives in a core team of key leaders who can help to establish new ministries and small groups in our churches. It is so important that we also spend much time with the Lord seeking His guidance and direction for our churches, so that we allow His plan for our churches and ministries to unfold step by step.

It is so important that we also as pastors encourage all believers to flow in their spiritual gifts and calling. Every believer has an important ministry. (Ephesians 2:10)
