LOCAL MISSIONS: Again a major focus in 2016 will be on reaching out to those in our local communities with the love of Christ and the gospel message. Each week we have two street outreaches in Blacktown. Each Thursday night we also serve people tea and coffee as we engage with those in our community. Our weekly Friday Night Flinders Street Station outreach continues to be a key focus as we reach out to the marginalized in the city of Melbourne.

Our monthly Sunday free Bacon and Egg breakfast outreach and weekly Friday lunches at our Blacktown Centre are also helping us to connect with many in our Blacktown community. Our Melbourne Saturday night meeting continues to draw many new people as we provide a free dinner for those attending. Last year we were also blessed to have Donato Diele and his wife Mary joining our Melbourne leadership team.



CAROLS OUTREACH: The Carols by Candlelight Event held by Church of Hope and three other churches at the Blacktown Showground was a great success.

OVERSEAS MISSIONS: This year we will again be running our free 17 Week Evangelism and Ministry training course by email for several Pastors and Christians both here in Australia and overseas. Last year around 500 pastors from India, Africa and other countries participated in this course.

This year Pastor David Palmer and his wife Melanie will be joining Pastor Conrad on a two weeks mission's trip to India. The primary focus of this trip will be to help equip and encourage around 500 village and city pastors who have had little or no bible college training, as well as ministering in a number of churches in both Jaipur and Delhi.

A key focus of all four pastor's workshops will be to help prepare and empower the pastors to run their own workshops and the 17 week Evangelism and Ministry Training course, for their own networks of pastors after these workshops. (Itinerary Page 3)

AFRICA PASTORS WORKSHOPS

Many pastors have contacted us from Kenya wanting to be equipped through our church of Hope training manuals and workshops. As Kenya is a key country in East Africa and with our Church of Hope coordinator Bishop Benson living in Nairobi Kenya, a key focus for this year will be to equip many Kenyan pastors in workshops throughout Kenya.

In addition to supporting Bishop Benson in the running of these workshops, we will also be helping to support two other major Pastors Workshops that Bishop Benson will be teaching at. In Tanzania Pastor Ernest Nguvula is organizing a workshop for 100 pastors and in Ethiopia Pastor Tadele is organizing a workshop for 100 pastors. With the support of other churches and Christians we are hoping to resource many African pastors this year with manuals. As a team we can achieve much.



RESOURCING PASTORS WITH MANUALS: The Pastors Workshop Guidelines and Teachings manual which is given to all pastors at each workshop, is a tool to help them to run workshops for other groups of pastors.

BLACKTOWN MINISTRY FOCUS 2016

The focus for our work in Blacktown this year will again be on:

- Connecting with more people through community outreaches such as carols events and free monthly breakfasts and weekly lunches at our centre
- Continuing to reach out with the gospel to those in our community and in Penrith once a fortnight, and
- To help see healthy community developing amongst the marginalized in our city

This year we will also be focusing on:

- Raising up small group leaders to run bible studies (A key to helping people to grow in their faith)
- Pioneering a new Sunday afternoon worship meeting in Penrith later this year.
- Helping to encourage, equip and mobilize more Christians to evangelize in other places, and
- Connecting more with the marginalized youth
