Sorry about the delay in sending you this week's email. I spent much time yesterday fine tuning my preaching notes from the weekend which form part of this week's teachings.

Over the weekend I preached twice on this week's topic: The greatest is love

A church of loving Christians has the potential to transform their community for Christ.

All that we do must be under-girded by love. The key is that Jesus is always our first love and passion. When we touch His heart we have His compassion for people which causes us to reach to others with the good news of the gospel AND to lay down our lives for others.

In the times that we are living in (2 Timothy 3:1-5) and the great need for so many to hear the gospel, how we need to encourage all Christians to keep their love for Jesus Christ and for others alive and strong and to be prepared to give of themselves to help others.

Jesus Himself warned us that because of lawlessness the love of many would grow cold just prior to His return. (Matthew 24:12)

It is so important that we are close to the Lord in these days and that our love for Jesus is burning brightly. If our church is full of believers who love to worship the Father in spirit and truth, all of the ministries that flow out of our churches will be under girded by Christ's love and make a great difference in our communities. We must not become like the church at Ephesus that had left their first love, even though they were full of good works. (Revelation 2:1-5)
